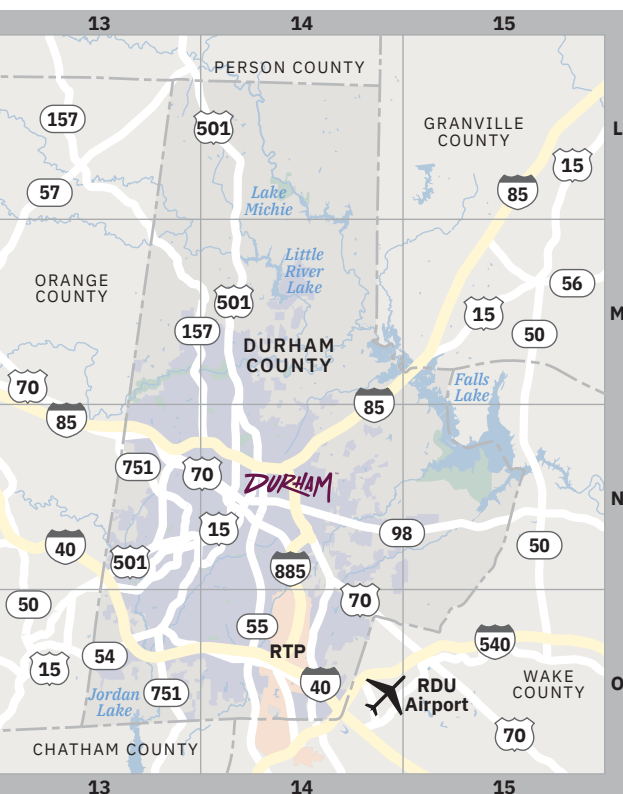
Ever-changing. Never changing.

Durham is within a one-hour flight or a day's drive of half the nation's population. We like to say we're at the center of it all.

RDU International Airport offers 360 daily flights with approximately 80 nonstop destinations, both domestic and international. More than 15 million passengers fly through RDU annually.

RESEARCH TRIANGLE PARK AREA

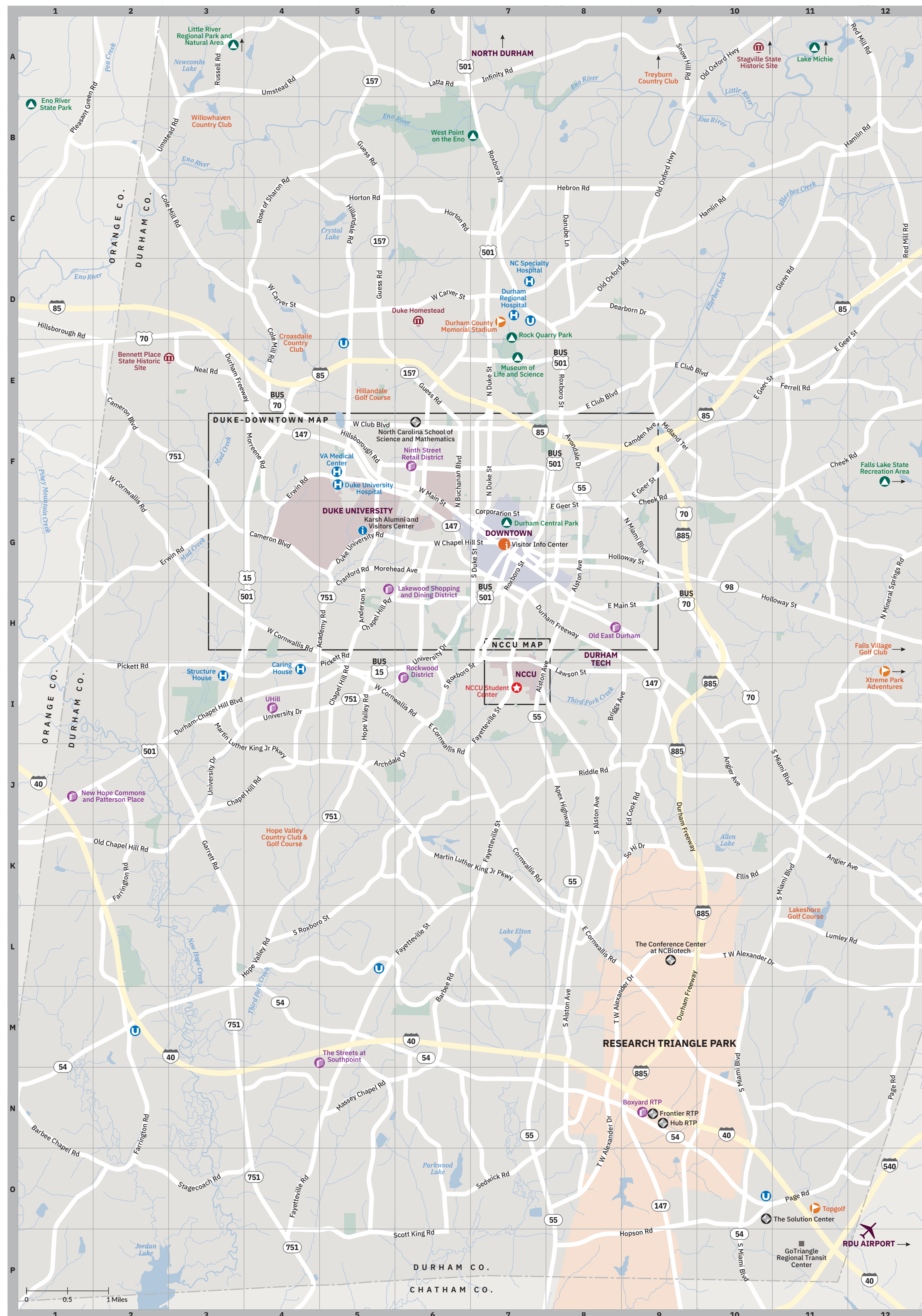

Science & Nature

Durhamites have invented the barcode, BC Headache Power, AZT, 3-D ultrasound, Astroturf and LED lighting. Our culture of innovation inspires everyday science and learning for visitors, too. Spark your curiosity at the nationally recognized **Museum of Life and Science**, **Duke Lemur Center**, and **Research Triangle Park**. The city is also replete with natural beauty that must be experienced to be appreciated. Nature aficionados can take in the **Sarah P. Duke Gardens**, as well as hiking trails and scenic river views at the **Eno River State Park** or **Lake Michie**.



Historic Sites & Museums

What began as the home of two Native American tribes continues as a destination praised for its work in technology, education and healthcare. It is of little surprise that Durham's past is eventful and noteworthy. We have three state historic sites here, more than any other county in N.C. – **Historic Stagville**, **Bennett Place**, and **Duke Homestead** – with other enclaves of storytelling like **Museum of Durham History**. History buffs, come ready to explore: from historic tobacco mills revitalized in our urban core to preserved homesteads sharing lessons from the past, you're invited to travel through our time.



Arts & Culture Venues

Here, muralists create treasured masterpieces on our brick-laden facades, galleries can be perused at your own leisure and iron wrought sculptures serve as time capsules. Art and culture course through Durham's soul; we are home to immigrant-created exhibits, historical stages and spectacular festivals. Our boundless talent and unapologetic creativity mean we've got an event calendar that isn't for the faint of heart. Take it all in at the **Nasher Museum of Art**, **DPAC**, **Durham Arts Council** and the **Carolina Theatre**, among many other venues.



Sports & Recreation

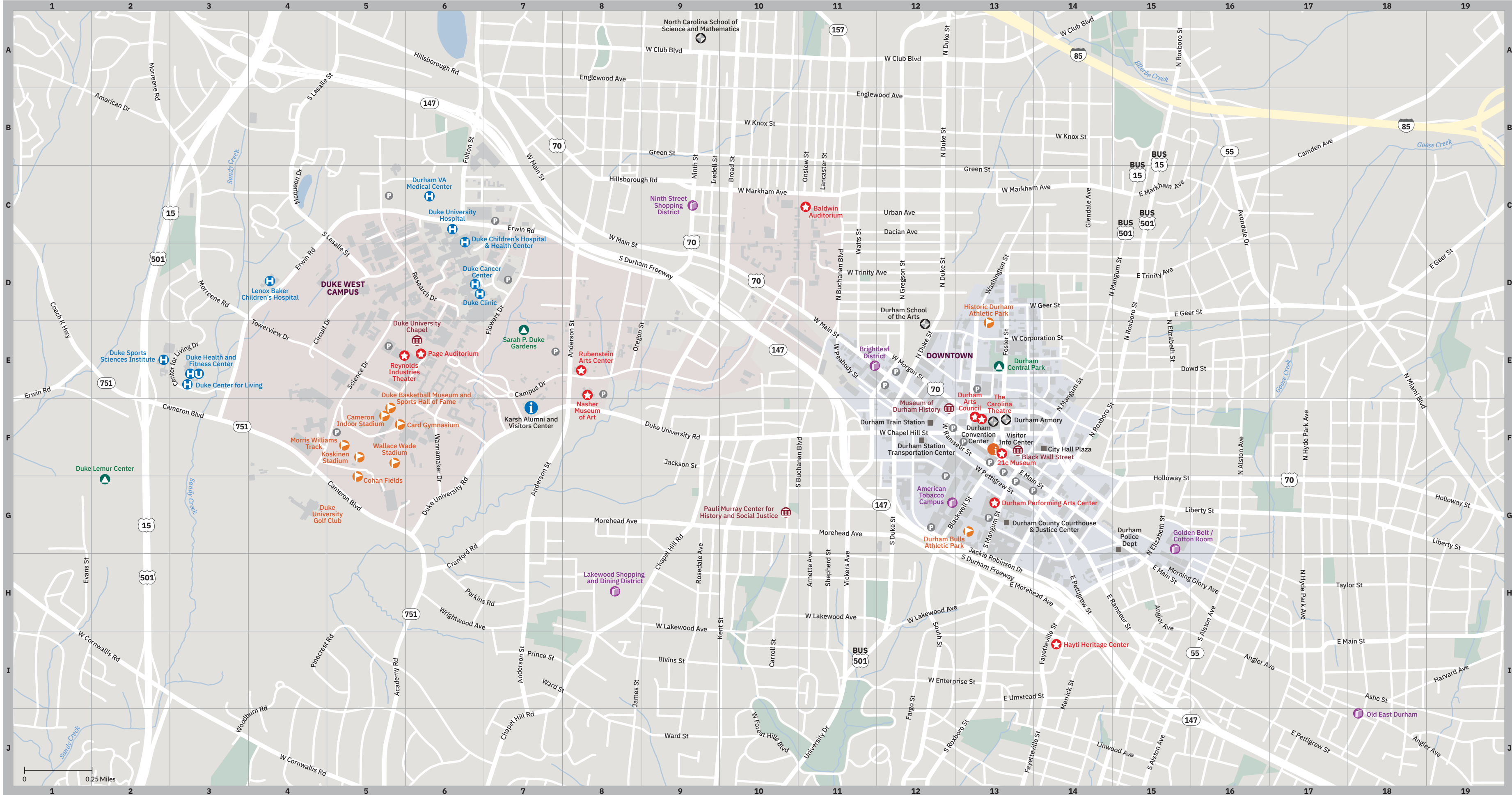

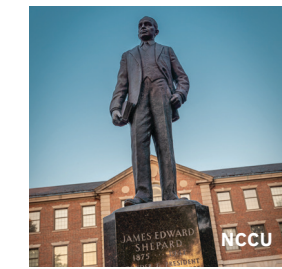
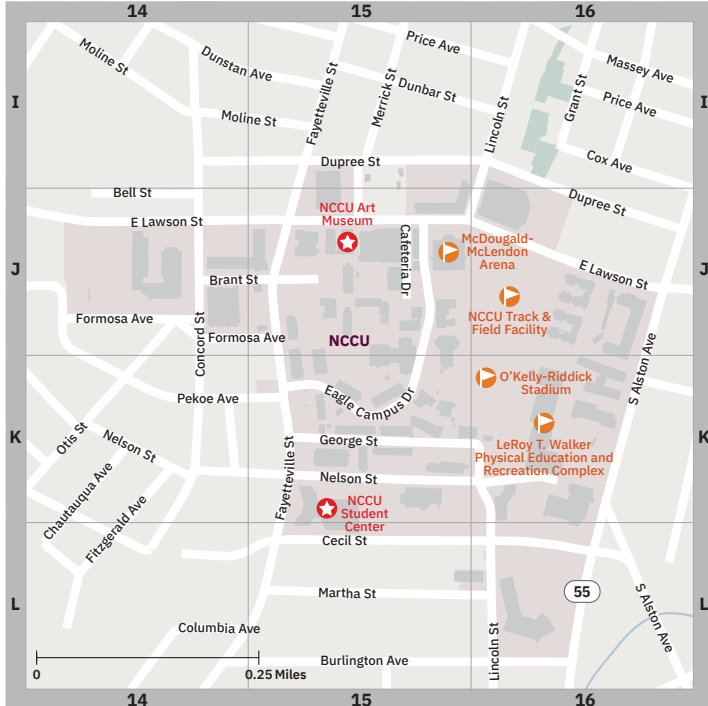
DOWNTOWN & NEARBY

NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY (NCCU)

Just south of the historic Hayti community is the nation's first publicly funded liberal arts college for African Americans. It is home to a buzzing campus, athletic venues, and artistic and historic events year-round.
